- Located in San Francisco, California
- Since its inception, the Fund has awarded over \$553 million in grants
- Over the past five years, 2012-2016, the Fund has awarded grants totaling approximately \$133 million
- In 2016, the Fund awarded grants totaling \$23.4 million
- Assets as of year-end 2016 were \$452 million
- Grantmaking in five program areas: Immigrant Rights and Integration, Gay and Lesbian Rights, Education Equity, Haas Leadership Initiatives and Community Partnerships and Initiatives

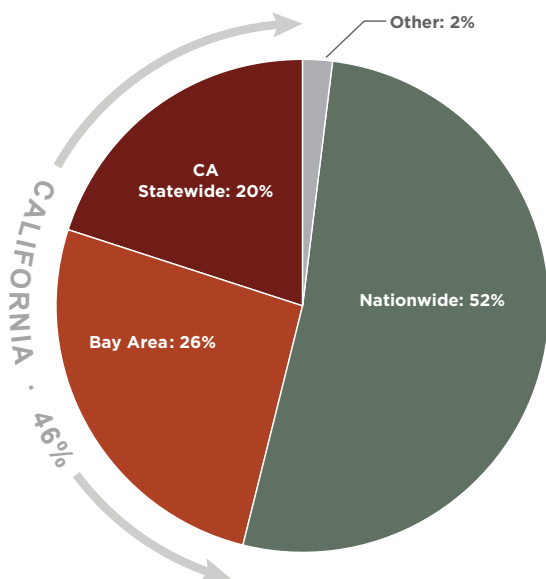

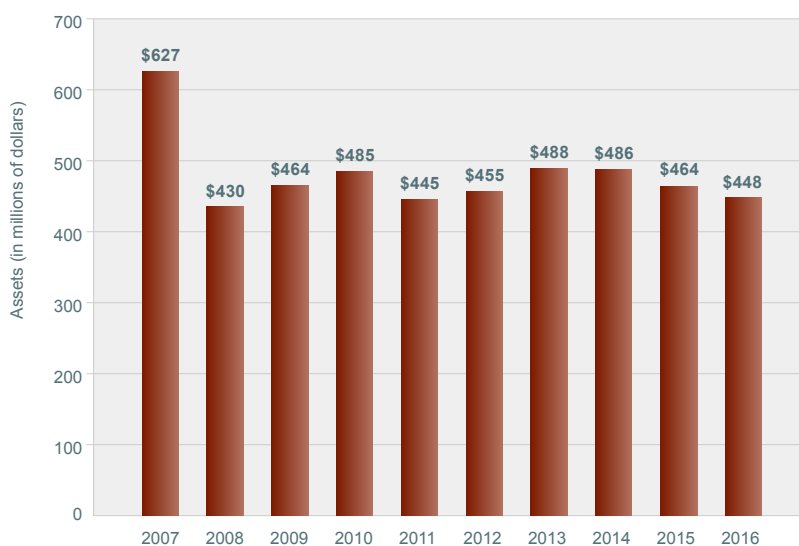
